REPORT OF THE BOARD OF BAR EXAMINERS ON ADMISSION TO THE BAR

**RE: BAR EXAMINATION HELD
February 26 & 27, 2013**

FINAL REPORT

MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT:

The Board of Bar Examiners respectfully reports to the Court that it conducted an examination for admission to the Bar of this State on February 26 & 27, 2013 at the Clarion Hotel in Lexington, Kentucky.

At said time and place, there appeared one hundred and ninety-two (192) applicants to take the bar examination. One hundred and ninety-one (191) applicants have been certified by the Character and Fitness Committee as qualified to be admitted to the practice of law in the Commonwealth of Kentucky upon receiving a passing grade on said examination.

Of the one hundred and ninety-one (191) applicants who were certified to take the examination, one hundred and forty-one (141) passed and fifty (50) failed.

Of the one hundred and ninety-one (191) applicants who were certified to take the examination, sixty-five (65) took both the essay and the Multistate Bar Examination ("MBE") portions of the examination, eighty-three (83) took the essay portion only and forty-three (43) took the MBE only.

Of sixty-five (65) who took both the essay and the MBE portions of the examination, forty (40) passed both portions, five (5) failed the essay and MBE portions, four (4) failed the essay portion and sixteen (16) failed the MBE portion.

Of the eighty-three (83) who took the essay portion of the examination, seventy-five (75) passed and eight (8) failed.

Of the forty-three (43) who took the MBE portion of the examination, twenty-six (26) passed and seventeen (17) failed.

The following persons, who were certified as qualified for admission as aforesaid by the Character and Fitness Committee, received a passing score on the subjects submitted to them.


FINAL RECOMMENDATION

The Board of Bar Examiners, therefore, respectfully recommends that each of the persons named above be admitted to practice law in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.


