

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RULE 1 - INTRODUCTION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

1.1 These Court Practice and Procedure Rules shall govern civil and criminal proceedings in the 43rd Judicial Circuit unless the same conflict with any statute or other law of the United States or Commonwealth of Kentucky, at any time legally adopted, in which event any such statute, law, rule, or order shall at all times prevail. All local court rules presently in effect in the 43rd Judicial Circuit are hereby repealed.

1.2 These rules shall become effective on June 1, 1994, subject to approval by the Chief Justice of Kentucky prior to that date.

1.3 These rules may be cited "LR 43 Rule \_\_\_\_".

RULE 12 - DISTRICT COURT RULES

12.1 Rules of the Circuit Court shall apply to the District Court where applicable.

12.2 All motions shall be in writing and served upon the adverse party pursuant to The Rule of Procedure. Motions and probate petitions shall be heard by scheduled appointments with the Court at the mutual convenience of the Court and parties. Default judgments, agreed orders and "Have Seen" orders may be submitted to the Court without appearance of counsel.


