



**NOTICE CONCERNING A VACANCY
IN THE OFFICE OF
CIRCUIT JUDGE
30TH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, DIVISION 6**

The resignation of Honorable Martin F. McDonald, effective January 31, 2009, has created a vacancy in the office of Circuit Judge, 30th Judicial Circuit, Division 6, consisting of Jefferson County. To be eligible to serve as a Circuit Judge you must:

- (a) be a citizen of the United States;
- (b) have been a resident of both the Commonwealth of Kentucky and of the district in which you seek appointment for two years next preceding taking office, and
- (c) be licensed to practice law in the courts of the Commonwealth as well as a licensed attorney for at least eight years.

Any person meeting these qualifications and desiring consideration for nomination to the Governor, or any citizen desiring to recommend a person or persons with these qualifications, shall notify the Judicial Nominating Commission by communicating the name(s) on or before **May 29, 2009** (see SCR 6.030). A questionnaire will be forwarded to those individuals. Anyone interested in being considered for the vacancy must return the completed questionnaire along with nine (9) copies on or before **June 12, 2009**, to the address below:
