
**ORDER**



IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

Unless otherwise directed by the Court, the following will govern the docketing of motions in the 25<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Family Court: The Clerk shall keep a motion docket for each division on which the Clerk will docket all motions assigned for hearing on each Motion Day. All cases must be placed on the Motion Docket by the close of business on the Monday preceding the regular Monday Motion Day (unless that Monday is a holiday, in which event, it shall be the close of business on the preceding Friday) and by the close of business on the Tuesday preceding the regular Tuesday Motion Day to stand for hearing on the following regular Motion Day. Any exception to this docketing rule shall be by leave of Court only, and the Clerk is directed to close the docket for the next Motion Day at the close of business on the preceding Monday or Tuesday. Any motion not accompanied by notice of date for hearing shall be summarily overruled except for good cause shown.
