ORDER

**In Re: Amendments to the Rules of Administrative Procedure
 AP Part XIV, Pretrial Services**

It is HEREBY ORDERED that Part XIV of the Rules of Administrative Procedure, Pretrial Services, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2

1. Within twenty-four hours of a defendant's incarceration on aailable offense, Pretrial Services must provide the judge or trial commissioner with information to assist the determination of pretrial release and supervision, including an assessment of risks posed by the defendant and recommendations for responding to the risks through use of appropriate conditions of release.
2. Information provided to the judge or trial commissioner will be obtained through Pretrial Services' investigation, including the interview of the defendant and the risk assessment.
3. Failure by Pretrial Services to present this information to the judge or trial commissioner within twenty-four hours of a defendant's incarceration will not result in the automatic release of a defendant.
4. The twenty-four hour time period referenced in this rule will revert to a twelve-hour time period on June 30, 2013, absent further orders of the Court.

This Order shall be effective at 12:01 a.m. on October 21, 2012, and until further Order.
