Public invited to give input on foster care system at regional community forums

The public is invited to attend regional community forums on improving outcomes for Kentucky children and families involved in the foster care system. Local Citizen Foster Care Review Boards statewide are hosting the forums to give the public the opportunity to discuss concerns regarding the state foster care system, including barriers to getting children into permanent homes in a timely manner and ensuring their well-being and safety while in foster and other out-of-home care. Specific case information will not be discussed due to confidentiality.

Findings from the forums will be reported to the Kentucky Citizen Foster Care Review Board and will be included in the state CFCRB's annual recommendations to the Supreme Court, governor and legislature. Regional forums are among the reforms called for in House Bill 1, the adoption and foster care legislation passed in 2018 to improve outcomes for children in out-of-home care.
